Andy Ayers Anderson, age 75, of Xenia, Ohio passed away unexpectedly on Monday, September 12, 2022. Andy was born on June 20, 1947 in Shelby Gap, Kentucky to Andy Anderson and Flora Ellen (Bumgardner) Anderson, his parents preceded him in death, along with his brother Gregory. He is survived by his wife Wanda (Mullins) Anderson and his brother William "Randy" Anderson. 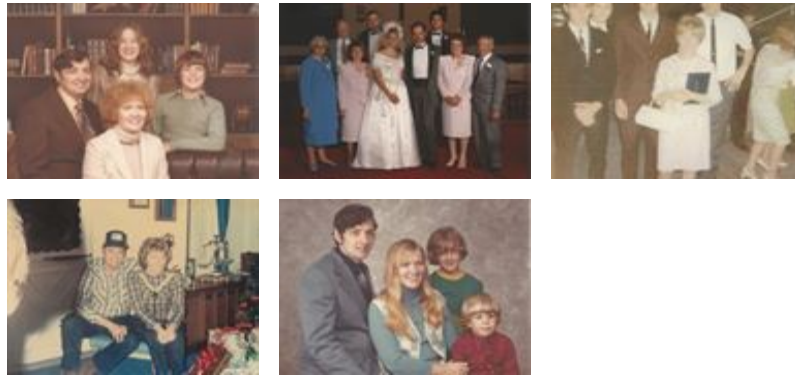
