Before giving his life to Jesus Christ, he saw what great things God had done for me. He would ask on several occasions, Who do you know? I would reply “the God above”

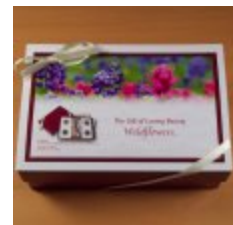
I thank the God that he gave his life over to Jesus, the last time we talked, he called to ask about something biblical.
