With thanksgiving to God for his life as husband and father the family announces the home going of Eddie Keith Mullins on September 17, 2012. He is survived by his loving family; wife Kathy (Reinke) of almost 33 years, daughters Cassie, Rachel and Shelby, mother Beulah Faye (Sowards) and brother Jeffrey Scott.

Eddie asked the Lord Jesus into his heart in December 1978. He said the worst thing anyone could say about him was that they didn't know he was a Christian. Everyone knew his favorite Bible verse was John 14:6, "Jesus said, 'I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except by Me.'"

Eddie worked for Beth-Elkhorn at Mine #29 for 4 ½ years. After surviving a roof collapse in 1978, he retired from coal mining and went to college. He received BA from Pikeville College and MEd from Morehead State University. Eddie taught school for 23 years – 1 year at Hellier Elementary, 15 years at Deerfield Beach Middle and 7 years at Coral Springs Christian Academy. He had a way with his students that made them feel special and he had a profound impact on their lives. Some of his favorite hobbies were collecting tie clips and pocket knives, reading Conan the Barbarian Comics and telling jokes.

Eddie fought a long battle with liver disease. His family fought with and for him. They are forever grateful for the extra months given to him after his liver transplant. He is now in heaven, walking on streets of gold, and no longer

suffering. We will see him again.

There will be a graveside service, Saturday March 2nd at 1pm at the Sowards Cemetery at Lick Fork of Beefhide and fellowship following at Beefhide Christian and Missionary Alliance Church.
