Ellis Branham, 80, of Harold, Ky, husband of Hester Hall Branham, entered his Heavenly home on Thursday March 19, 2026. He was born in Grethel, Ky on May 1, 1945 to Troy and Stella Tackett Branham. He grew up in a large, close-knit family and had a special unbreakable bond with his brothers and sisters. His supportive wife, daughter, family and firm belief in God carried him during his final days.

Ellis lived in Clyde, OH for more than 20 years and worked at General Motors, he then moved back to his home state of Kentucky in 1980 and began a coal truck until he retired in the late 90's.
