August 14, 1914 - August 17, 2010

Goldie Benedict, 96 of Virgie, died August 17, 2010 after a long illness at the Parkview Nursing and Rehab Center.

She was born on August 14, 1914 at Sugar Creek, Ohio to the late Steve and Susan Bunch Benedict.

She was a member of the Virgie Baptist Church, a charter member of the Virgie Baptist Church Women's Missionary Union since 1960 and a Sunday school teacher for 10 years.

She was a retired Pike County School teacher having taught at Virgie and G.F. Johnson Elementary schools for 36 years, taught 7 summers at Pikeville College, Kentucky Retired Teachers Associations and a Kentucky Colonel. Goldie served as Board Member and Chairman of the Pike County Chapter of American Red Cross for 17 years, a former member of the Pike County American Association of University Women and was named Woman of the year in 1987, a member of the Wheelwright Chapter of Eastern Star for 30 years.

Other than her parents she was preceded in death by one brother; Steve Benedict, Jr., five sisters; Elizabeth Kennard, Mary Brummett, Hilda Benedict, Erma Reynolds and Rosa Long.

She is survived by one brother; Johnny (Marge) Benedict of Virgie and their two daughters; Jonna Benedict and her son Adam of Harrodsburg, Lisa (Kevin) Campbell and their daughter and grandson; Olivia Grace and Benjamin of Franklin, along with a host of special nieces and nephews.
