Owsley Stanley Johnson, 95 years of age of Virgie, Ky., passed away Sunday, August 11, 2013 at his residence. He was born at ETTY, Ky. on March 4, 1918 to the late George Franklin (G.F.) and Vesta Roberts Johnson.

He was a graduate of Virgie High School, Georgetown College and the University of Kentucky. While at Georgetown College he was a member of the Pi Kappa Alpha Fraternity.

Mr. Johnson was a retired school teacher and bus driver at Virgie High School. He was a member of PCEA, KEA and NEA. He also was a World War II Veteran, having served in the United States Air Force. Most importantly, he was led to the Lord by Pastor Dave Hammond of Faith Baptist Church at Myra.

Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Norma Ratliff Johnson, who passed away Nov. 3, 1981; three brothers: Woodrow W. Johnson, George F. Johnson, Jr., Charles Johnson and two sisters: Marie Anderson and Irene Spence.
