September 20, 1931 - March 31, 2010

Ronald Keith Curry age 78 of Indian Creek Rd, passed away Wednesday, March 31, 2010 at his residence. He was born in Floyd County on September 20, 1931 to the late Paul and Della Johnson Curry.

He was a retired Army Veteran, a member of the Virgie Baptist Church, a member of the Retired School Teachers Association having taught in Michigan for 2 years and in Pike County for 35 years. He coached baseball, football, volleyball and basketball. He also taught swimming lessons at Wheelwright and Virgie.

Other than his parents he was preceded in death by two brothers; Charles and Forest Curry.
